

Agility Committee

Purpose: Promote the sport of agility and assist local clubs in the planning, development and holding of agility programs and owner education.

Organization: Chairperson appointed annually by the Board of Directors and committee members selected by the Chairperson.

Committee Chair Qualifications: Knowledge of all facets of agility training and exhibiting as well as experience in the sport. Ability to communicate by email.

Committee Responsibilities:

1. Help plan and oversee the agility trial portion of the National Specialty.
2. Advise WCA Board of Directors on any matters related to agility brought before the WCA.
3. Promote The Weimaraner Standard in all phases of agility training & exhibiting.
4. Write articles for *The Weimaraner Magazine* on recent Weimaraners titling in agility and other subjects of interest to the membership.
5. Answer correspondence regarding agility from the membership.
6. Obtain recognition of agility achievements on the national level.
7. Maintain records of committee activity.

Board Reports: Submit report to the Secretary of the Board of Directors 6 weeks prior to each meeting of the Board of Directors.

1. Summarizing committee activity since the last Board of Directors meeting.
2. Include in the report any recommended changes to:
 - a. WCA Rules or procedures related to the Committee
 - b. Committee responsibilities
 - c. Committee organization
 - d. Committee Chair qualifications
