There will be no refund for duplicate entries.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the Club nor its Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.**

WCA reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.

The show giving Club, the Show Secretary, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by telegram prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

Non Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

Veteran Dog: for dogs at least 7 years of age (same class for bitches). Spayed bitches and neutered dogs eligible for Veterans Class.

Field Trial Dog: for dogs that have placed in an AKC Licensed or Member Field Trial or who have been awarded an AKC Hunting Test Title or who have been awarded a WCA Field or Water Rating prior to the closing date of this Show. (Same class for bitches).

Versatile Dog: for dogs who have been awarded a Versatile Rating from the WCA prior to the closing date of this Show. (Same class for bitches).

Versatile Excellent Dog: for dogs who have been awarded a Versatile Excellent Rating from the WCA prior to the closing date of this Show. (Same class for bitches).

Best of Breed Competition

Those dogs and bitches, excluding BOB and BOS, who have made the judge's final cut remain in the ring for the WCA Award of Merit. The judge may choose up to six to receive the award. Those receiving the award will not be ranked nor chosen on the basis of sex. All awards to be made at the discretion of the judge.

Non Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Stud Dog: for Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Get only to be judged based on the merits of the Get. Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed or some Non-Regular Class other than Stud Dog Class.

Brood Bitch: substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Progency for Get.

As the Judge's decision in the Stud Dog & Brood Bitch classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

After approximately 2.2 miles, turn right on Prather Road. There is a sharp right on Prather Road about 4.6 miles from Old Highway 99. Turn left there on Michigan Hill Road. The Tracking Test is for dogs not less than six months old. With the entry form in the TD Test of a dog which has not passed a "Tracking Test," there must be filed a Certification Statement by a person who is accredited by the AKC to judge a 'Tracking Test,' that the dog is considered by the judge to be ready for such a test. An exhibitor may enter more than one dog. Entries without a TD or TDX title will be given preference for each test. Note: If the limit for entries is not reached in one test and the limit is exceeded in the other test, the number of tracks will be exchanged up to the limit set by the AKC Tracking Regulations.

The Tracking Dog Test will be limited to 4 Weimaraners; the Tracking Dog Excellent Test will be limited to 2 Weimaraners. If the limit in any of the tests is not reached in Weimaraners, other breeds may enter using the following procedure: Draw (1) Weimaraners without a title, Draw (2) Weimaraners with a title, Draw (3) Other breeds without a title, Draw (4) Other breeds with a title. Bitches in season may participate (refer to AKC Tracking Regulations, Chapter 2, Section 8, and notify Test Secretary prior to the drawing for track order on the day of the test).

There will be no actual scores for TD or TDX Tests, but dog will be rated "Passed" or "Failed" and TD or TDX certificate will be issued by AKC confirming all dogs rated "Passed".

Telegraph, telephone, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of entry forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Entries sent by overnight delivery service MUST include signature release.

In accordance with the AKC Obedience Regulations (Chapter 1, Section 4), entries in this TD/TDX tests will be accepted up until the official closing date, even though the advertised limit has been reached. A drawing will be held at Denny's Restaurant, 5700 Southcenter Blvd, Tukwila, WA 98188 (206) 246-0476 on Monday, April 13, 2009 at 6:00 p.m. to determine which entries will participate in the test. When the advertised limit has been drawn, all remaining entries, subject to the same preferences set forth above, will be similarly drawn and assigned a position on an alternate list. The Test Secretary will then notify all entries of the results of the draw. Entries will be acknowledged with a draw number and map and directions to the test site. There will be no drawing if the advertised limit is not reached.

In the event that an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, it will be the responsibility of the Test Secretary to determine if alternates are present, and to determine, by their position on the Alternate List, which alternates shall participate. NO entry fee will be refunded except that of an alternate who does not participate or an entry who withdraws if an alternate is available to take their place and whose entry fee will be refunded within seven days following the test.

The assignment of dogs to the tracks, by the drawing of lots, is the responsibility of the judges.

The Western Section of the Weimaraner Club of America 2009 Show Futurity will be judged at this show. All dogs/bitches entered in the Futurity must be entered in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Conformation Classes of the National Specialty Show. A \$20.00 entry fee is required to enter the Futurity after the dog/bitch has been properly entered in one of the Specialty Classes. Indicate Futurity Class on the entry form in the space provided for Additional Classes.

Division of entry money as prizes: 50% of all moneys paid into the Futurity Program retained by the Weimaraner Club of America for expenses. The purse will be divided on a sectional basis reflecting the total number of dogs/bitches in competition. After the monies for each show sectional have been computed, the division shall continue as follows: 1/7th each to the Winners (First place in each of the classes: Senior, Intermediate, Junior - dogs & bitches) 1/14th (additional) to Best Dog in Futurity and to Best Bitch in Futurity. Each Winner's share will be divided further and paid in this manner: 60% to Owner, 40% to Breeder. Notice: All entries must comply with the rules governing the Weimaraner Club of America's Show Futurity. Exhibitor is solely responsible for knowledge of and compliance with those rules.

The Western Section of the Weimaraner Club of America 2009 Show Maturity will be judged at this show. All dogs/bitches entered in the Maturity must have been eligible for a Sectional Show Futurity and must be entered in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Conformation Classes of the National Specialty Show. A \$30.00 entry fee is required to enter the Maturity after the dog/bitch has been properly entered in one of the Specialty Classes. Indicate Maturity Class on the entry form in the space provided for Additional Classes.

Division of entry money as prizes: The monies collected from the initial litter registration forfeits, as well as late penalty fees will be considered the Breeder's contribution. 50% of the Breeder's contribution will be retained by the Weimaraner Club of America for expenses. 1/4 of the total remainder of the Breeder's contribution will be joined to the entry fees collected at each Sectional Maturity to be awarded to the owners of the four placements in dogs and bitches. The available monies will be divided 1/2 for dogs and 1/2 for bitches in this manner: 40% to first, 30% to second, 20% to third and 10% to fourth.
