DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months and over that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have obtained AKC ILP/PAL numbers except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog’s physical or mental performance.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION AND WARM-UPS

Handlers in all classes may walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors.

Height Cards:

You must include a photocopy of your jump height card with your entry. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** If you did not include a copy, you will have to show it prior to running your dog. If your dog has not been measured, please indicate it on your entry. All dogs without height cards will need to be measured by the judge prior to running in it's first class, except 24"/26" unless a VMO or REP is present.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

These Agility Trials will be held outdoors on grass.

Ring size will be 100 x 100

The Weimaraner Club of America assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

The health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors, judges and spectators is of paramount importance. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Aggressive dogs will not be allowed. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Move-ups after entries close must be submitted in writing to the Trial secretary not later than 6 pm PST, Monday, May 4, 2009. Dog's call name, breed, AKC reg.#, title completed and date, class currently entered, new class requested, owner's name and date

E-mail move-ups will only be official after e-mail conformation of move-up is sent. Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks, for entering the same dog twice or for entering a dog in a class in which it is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such errors. Dogs wrongly entered in a class may not be transferred to another class after entries close. (Except for move-up provisions as specified above)

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

Entries, which are Incorrect, Illegible, or Incomplete, will not be accepted and will be returned to the exhibitor.

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of AKC forms **without the agreement and rules attached are not acceptable.** E-mail or FAX entries will not be accepted. If you send an entry in Fed X or overnight mail, **PLEASE check the "NO SIGNATURE" box.** Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging will be sent to the address on the Official AKC entry form after closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule within seven days of the show, contact the Trial Secretary.

Entry Fees will not be refunded in event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee.

Judging Schedule: Judging will start no earlier than 9:00 am.

All classes will be in one ring . **FAST** classes will be at the end of the day.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Height Divisions: Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions.

Please Note: We will not be doing formal check-in at the show. Armband labels will be in a **NOTEBOOK** at a **CHECK-IN TABLE** in **ALPHABETICAL, LAST NAME ORDER.**

If you have not attached a height card with your entry, your armband will be with the trial secretary at the score table.

Exhibitors should check in directly with the gate steward unless you need to present your height card or your dog needs to be measured.

ONLINE ENTRIES

YOU CAN ENTER ONLINE AT WWW.R2AGILITYONLINE.COM

WCA is accepting online entries through the **R2AgilityOnline system.** During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online entries or paper entries will be as follows: Online Entries: 45%, Paper entries: 55%. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time limit period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly.

A maximum of 10 entries per envelope is allowed. Envelopes with more than 10 entries and/or entries received prior to the opening date will be returned.

Paper entries received within 24 hours of the opening date and time must:

1. include postage or be metered;
2. be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender.
3. Express mail must be designated "no signature required"

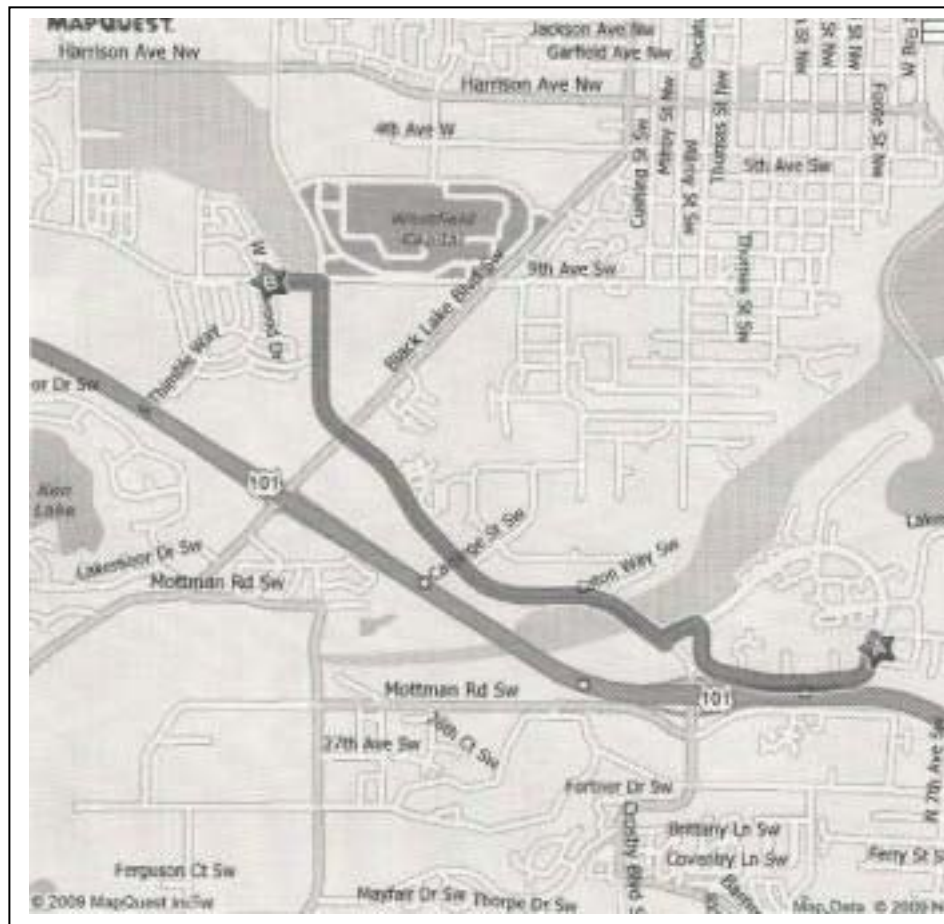
Directions:

Turn Left to stay on Evergreen Park Dr. SW (0.1 mi)

Turn Right onto Cooper Point Dr. SW (.1.2 mi)

Turn Left onto Capitol Mall Dr. SW (0.1 mi)

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all *Regular* titling classes and the *FAST* titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

Dogs entered in the *Preferred* classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial or *back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
