

Junior Program Committee

Purpose: To encourage and promote interest in Weimaraners in our young adults and honor those who show outstanding qualities in furthering the capabilities of the Weimaraner.

Organization: Chairperson appointed annually by the Board of Directors and committee members selected by the Chairperson.

Committee Chairperson Qualifications: Extensive experience in junior showmanship, imagination, organizational skills and dedication to furthering the program. Knowledge of the AKC Junior Showmanship regulations and the WCA Junior Program rules. Ability and time to write a Junior Showmanship article each month and to communicate with youngsters, parents and board members. Ability to communicate by email.

Committee Responsibilities:

1. Write an interesting, informative, and relevant column each month for *The Weimaraner Magazine*.
2. Provide a monthly list of all Junior placements for publication in *The Weimaraner Magazine*.
3. Solicit articles from knowledgeable members to instruct our juniors in different categories or versatility.
4. Receive applications and make recommendations to the Board of Directors for granting of awards according to the Junior Program rules.
5. Find juniors who are not WCA members, send them a membership application and get them involved in the sport.
6. Find junior aged WCA members and get them involved.

Board Reports: Submit report to the Secretary of the Board of Directors 6 weeks prior to each meeting of the Board of Directors:

1. Summarizing Committee activity since the last Board of Directors meeting
2. Include in the report any recommended changes to:
 - a. WCA rules or procedures related to the Committee
 - b. Committee responsibilities
 - c. Committee organization
 - d. Committee Chair qualifications
