

Ways and Means Committee

Purpose: Raise money for the WCA by selling WCA logo items.

Organization: Committee Chairperson appointed by the Board of Directors and members selected by the Chairperson.

Committee Chairperson Qualifications: Knowledge of trophies, awards, silk-screening and embroidery. A basic eye for quality and a feel for what the Weimaraner buyer would purchase. Ability to communicate by email.

Committee Responsibilities:

1. Get artwork and designs for silk-screening, find a reliable person to do the silk-screening, get a number of prices for comparison. Purchase articles of clothing, i.e. sweatshirts, always with a mind for quality and price savings. All of this is for raising money for the WCA. An inventory must be made so one will know when it is time for a new fund raising project.
2. Order ribbons for the six (6) Award of Merits at the National Specialty and send to the chairman.
3. Order Top Producing sire and dam trophies for presentation at the National Specialty.
4. Have any special awards, i.e. BROM pins, designed, take prices back to the Board and have made.
5. Be available to assist the National Show Trophy Chairperson.
6. Purchase or have made any special awards, i.e. gifts for outstanding members.

Board Reports: Submit report to the Secretary of the Board of Directors 6 weeks prior to each meeting of the Board of Directors:

1. Summarizing Committee activity since the last Board of Directors meeting
2. Include in the report any recommended changes to:
 - a. WCA rules or procedures related to the Committee
 - b. Committee Responsibilities
 - c. Committee organization
 - d. Committee Chair Qualifications
